NOTICE

Central Coast Artists Collective ceased accepting memberships in the four artist groups on its website as of September 1, 2025. It was decided by a vote of the CCAC Board to reduce Collective services on December 31, 2025.

The Collective was formed to provide services (bank accounts, memberships, exhibition assistance, website, newsletter, etc.) to artist groups to make up for those which the SLO Museum previously provided. Though the Collective was successful in its efforts, the need for those services has diminished.

Artist groups can continue to exist as separate entities, having meetings, exhibitions, etc. They can opt to chart their own courses under the umbrella of the Collective but with limited services, beginning in January 2026.

If you are a current member of an artist group (Photo Society, The Painters Group, Central Coast Sculptors, or Craftmakers), your membership is valid through December 31, 2025. You will receive notices from your group, the website will continue, and you will receive the monthly newsletter through December.

Your artist group will provide you with more information about how they plan to operate in the future.
